

# **Dress Code**

The Craigslea State High School Uniform Policy has been developed through consultation with the school's Parents and Citizens' Association.

The student dress code contributes to a safe and supportive teaching and learning environment through:

- ready identification of students and non-students at school
- fostering a sense of belonging
- developing mutual respect among students.

Craigslea State High School has two distinct uniforms - the formal uniform and sport uniform.

Years 7 to 10: The sport uniform may be worn to and from school only on designated sport days. When students are going to participate in practical activities for Health and Physical Education, Drama or Dance, students will be advised by their teachers and they will be permitted to wear their sport uniform on that day.

Years 11 and 12: The formal uniform is to be worn every day. HPE, Drama and Dance students are required to change for lessons.

Year 12 students have the opportunity to purchase a senior jersey. These senior jerseys are designed as a memento of the students' senior year and can be worn to school during Terms 2, 3 and only on the last day of Term 4. All other uniform expectations remain in place.

The formal uniform is to be worn by all students on all school excursions unless otherwise stipulated in writing.

# **Formal Uniform**

Item		How / when worn
Shirt (tucked in)	<ul> <li>Plain white long sleeve business shirt worn with the school tie (this shirt is of a conventional button through style) or</li> <li>White short sleeve school shirt with CSHS logo</li> </ul>	It must be worn tucked into shorts or trousers. The collar must be turned down. Sleeves are not to be rolled up.
Shorts	Black tailored shorts	The length of the shorts is to the top of the knee.
Trousers	Black tailored long trousers	The length of the trousers is to the top of the heel at the back.
Belt	Black 30mm belt with plain silver buckle and/or black keeper	Shorts and trousers must be worn with the designated belt.
Tie	Craigslea tartan school tie	Worn to cover top button with length to belt buckle.
Shoes	<ul> <li>Black, hard leather lace up college style polished shoes (the only acceptable styles are pictured on page three)</li> </ul>	The backs must always be firm to support the heel. Shoes must be in good order and polished.
Socks	<ul> <li>Plain black socks with long trousers or white formal socks with CSHS stripes worn with shorts</li> </ul>	Plain black socks are to be worn with long trousers. White formal socks with CSHS stripes are to be worn with tailored shorts.
Jumper / Blazer	<ul> <li>Craigslea knitted V neck jumper, school blazer or school tracksuit jacket</li> </ul>	Sleeves are not to be pulled over the hands. They are to remain in good condition.
School Hats	<ul> <li>Craigslea sports hat</li> <li>Craigslea formal hat - optional</li> </ul>	Students are encouraged to wear the Craigslea school sports hat for all outdoor activities. These hats are compulsory for Sport and HPE. Worn with formal uniform.





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# **Formal Uniform**

Blouse	Formal green blouse	Appropriate size that does not allow flesh to be seen when arms are raised. All buttons done up and sleeves are not to be rolled up.
Skirt	Craigslea tartan skirt	Length to the knee or below. Worn at the waist.
Tie	Craigslea tartan school tie	Tied to cover top button.
Shoes	<ul> <li>Black, hard leather lace up college style polished shoes (the only acceptable styles are pictured on page three)</li> </ul>	The backs must always be firm to support the heel. Shoes must be in good order and polished.
Socks	<ul> <li>White formal socks with CSHS stripes worn with skirt or shorts, or plain black socks with long trousers</li> </ul>	White formal socks with CSHS stripes are to be worn with skirt or shorts. Plain black socks are to be worn with long trousers.
Stockings	<ul> <li>Full length plain black stockings</li> <li>optional</li> </ul>	Stockings are to be plain (not patterned) and in good condition without laddering or holes.
Trousers	Black tailored long trousers	The length of the trousers is to the top of the heel at the back.
Shorts	<ul> <li>Black tailored knee-length shorts</li> </ul>	The length of the shorts is to the top of the knee.
Jumper / Blazer	<ul> <li>Craigslea knitted V neck jumper, school blazer or school tracksuit jacket</li> </ul>	Sleeves are not to be pulled over the hands. They are to remain in good condition.
School Hats	<ul> <li>Craigslea sports hat</li> <li>Craigslea formal hat - optional</li> </ul>	Students are encouraged to wear the Craigslea school sports hat for all outdoor activities. These hats are compulsory for Sport and HPE. Worn with formal uniform.
Hair Ribbon	<ul> <li>The only hair adornment is a navy, white or green ribbon</li> </ul>	The ribbon must be worn over hair ties that blend with the student's hair colour.

# **Sport Uniform**

ltem		How / when worn	
Shirt	<ul> <li>Craigslea polo shirt with school logo</li> </ul>	Shirt is not tucked in. Sleeves are not to be rolled up.	
Shorts	<ul> <li>Craigslea sport shorts with CSHS initials</li> </ul>	To be worn at a length that finishes at the top of the knee.	
Sport shoes	<ul> <li>Plain jogger that is predominantly black or predominantly white in colour with matching laces.</li> <li>Slip on shoes and canvas type shoes are not acceptable</li> </ul>	Appropriate runners, joggers or cross trainers, predominantly black or white in colour. Laces are to be tied tightly with a bow at the top. Shoes are to be clean and in good order. High ankle basketball style boots, volleys, slippers, high tops or any shoes of canvas material are not permitted.	
Socks	<ul> <li>White sport socks with CSHS initials</li> </ul>	White sport socks with CSHS initials. The sock is to be seen above the shoe.	
School hats	Craigslea sports hat	Students are encouraged to wear the Craigslea school sports hat for all outdoor activities. These hats are compulsory for Sport and HPE.	
School Tracksuit	<ul> <li>Craigslea tracksuit jacket with school logo and tracksuit pants with white stripe</li> </ul>	This tracksuit may be worn during the cooler months. Sleeves and pant legs are not to be rolled up.	



Years 7 to 10: Sport uniform may be worn to and from school only on designated sport days. When students are going to participate in practical activities for Health & Physical Education, Drama or Dance, students will be advised by their teachers and they will be permitted to wear their sport uniform on that day.



# **Inclusive Options**

Craigslea aims to provide flexibility in accommodating individual student needs regarding the wearing of the school uniform. There are many personal circumstances which mean that a student may require variations to the school uniform and the school works with parents and students to manage these variations on a case-by-case basis, including for students who have gender identity requirements.

#### Footwear

#### **Formal Uniform**

It is important that students wear protective and appropriate footwear. Students must wear black hard leather lace up college style polished shoes (the only acceptable styles are pictured below).



# **Sport Uniform**

Our school dress code stipulates that the sport uniform be worn with appropriate runners, joggers or cross trainers, predominantly black or predominantly white in colour with black or white laces. High ankle basketball style boots, volleys, slippers, high tops or any shoes of canvas material are not permitted. In accordance with health and safety regulations and given that sport shoes are also worn in the classroom and school grounds, it is important that all members of our community are aware of our dress code. Please keep in mind that choosing the correct sport shoes for your student will enhance their physical activity and provide sound protection for their feet and body.



#### Jewellery and Grooming

Students are to be neat and well presented at all times.

- No visible makeup or nail polish is to be worn.
- Jewellery is restricted to a wrist watch, one set of plain studs or sleepers in the ears. Necklaces need to be of sufficient length that they are not visible. No visible facial piercings are permitted. No other jewellery is permitted.
- Hairstyles are to be conservative in style. Hair must be clean, tidy and pulled back to comply with workplace health and safety provisions. Students with long hair are encouraged to tie their hair back.
  - The only hair adornment is a navy, white or green ribbon.
  - Hair colours should be natural looking. Multiple tones are not appropriate.
  - Hairstyles such as mohawks, dreadlocks and rats tails are not appropriate.
  - Hair that is shaved around the perimeter or in unusual patterns is not appropriate.
- Students must be clean-shaven.



## **School Hats**

Students are encouraged to wear the Craigslea sports hat for all outdoor activities. These hats are compulsory for Sport and HPE. Craigslea formal hat is worn with the formal uniform - optional.

#### Winter

- No undershirts that are visible (at neck, sleeves or hip) are permitted. Singlets, very short sleeved undershirts or spencers are permitted providing they cannot be seen.
- No scarves, beanies or gloves are permitted. Students may keep warm in winter with non-visible undergarments, the school jumper or tracksuit.

# **Senior Jerseys**

Year 12 students have the opportunity to purchase a senior jersey. These senior jerseys are designed as a memento of the students' senior year and can be worn to school during Terms two, three, and only on the last day of Term four. All other uniform expectations remain in place.

#### **Uniform Shop**

The uniform shop operates twice a week at the school and is located beside the main entrance of the school hall.

#### Non-Compliance with the Dress Code

- A note from a parent/caregiver must be produced for any infringement of the school uniform and the student is required to present this to their relevant Year Level Coordinator or Deputy to receive a uniform pass (if approved).
- Students who are out of uniform will be requested to show their pass. If they do not have a pass, they will be directed to the relevant Year Level Coordinator or Deputy. Students who are wearing jewellery will be directed, in the first instance, to remove their jewellery. If a student refuses to do this, the relevant Year Level Coordinator or Deputy will be advised.
- Students who are out of uniform may be prevented from participating in any activity that, in the opinion of the principal, is not part of the essential educational program of the school.

# **Financial Hardship**

• The school provides a range of solutions to assist families in financial hardship. These include payment plan approaches that can be negotiated on a case by case basis.

Application may be made in writing to the Principal should a dress code variation be required. Appropriate documentation will be required to support the application.
