Signature Music is an extension program with a focus on performance that fosters creative potential. This subject is for students in Years 7 to 10 who demonstrate exceptional musical talent, instrumental and/or vocal and is studied for the full year. In years seven and eight students will learn the elements of Drama, Dance and Visual Art. Lessons will be in conjunction with our Instrumental Music teacher/s, with the aim of establishing industry links with professional associations. Entry into the program is by application, which will take place the year prior to entering high school.

Overview and Rationale

Music is an integral part of everyday life serving self-expressive, celebratory, social, cultural and educational roles. A study of music not only assists students in their own understanding and enjoyment of the arts, it helps them achieve excellent academic results in other subject areas through the promotion of healthy study and practice habits and creative thinking.

Aims and Objectives

Students will:

- develop the skills and knowledge that are vital for success as a modern musician
- listen to and experience music in a range of contemporary and traditional styles
- gain a deeper knowledge and understanding of musical theory
- try new performance options including duets, trios and small ensembles
- develop performance, composition and analytical skills through working closely with staff and industry professionals

Class Organisation

In 2024, there will be four Signature Music classes, each operating as **full year courses**:

1. Year 7 class

- studied for 2 x 70 minute lessons per week

2. Year 8 class

- studied for 2 x 70 minute lessons per week

3. Year 9 class

- studied for 3 x 70 minute lessons per week

4. Year 10 class

- studied for 3 x 70 minute lessons per week

Studies will be a rotation of the following topics:

Orchestral Music

Grade 1 Theory and Musicianship AMEB

Australian Music

Performing in small ensembles

Composing

Responding

Arranging

Students will study music in greater breadth and depth than their peers who will study classroom music for one semester in Year 7 or 8 and one semester in year 9 and 10.



Assessment and Reporting

Students in this class study a curriculum framed around Australian Curriculum, Assessment and Reporting Authority (ACARA). They are assessed in two main strands:

- Making
- Responding

Assessment instruments may include:

- Composing
- Aural Skills Tests
- Listening/Analysing Repertoire
- Music Project/Research/PowerPoint/Oral presentations
- Live performances for the school and wider community

A progress report is issued at the end of term 1 and an academic report issued at the end of each semester.

Maintenance of Position in the Program

- Current enrolment in at least one vocal or instrumental extra-curricular ensemble
- Compliance with school expectations regarding effort, behaviour and attendance
- Consistently high academic results and a willingness to go beyond their potential

Costs

There are no additional costs associated with this curriculum class other than the standard subject contribution levy for Music. Please be aware, however, that any excursions, workshops with professionals, etc. may require an additional fee depending on the activity.

- Submit the two minute video on a USB with scales and performance piece OR
- Submit the Recommendation from your Private or Tuition Teacher.
