



ASX Sharemarket Games

Students who elect a Business Studies unit in the junior school are provided with the opportunity to participate in the ASX Sharemarket game. The Game gives students hands-on experience of the sharemarket in 12 weeks on Internet share "trading", competing against teams from all States in Australia. The Game involves:

- Students forming a "syndicate" of two to four people;
- Each syndicate being given \$50,000 hypothetical capital; and
- Trading on the Internet choice from 100 ASX listed companies.

The Game is a reality share trading experience as everything the students have learned about the sharemarket comes to life as they can:

- buy and sell shares as often as they like providing they have the cash to spend;
- stay in touch with the market and take advantage of all the latest company announcements;
- graph the share price of all stocks in the game;
- set up a watch list of stocks, just like the professionals;
- check out the leaders in the State and National competition on the daily electronic ranking list leaders.
