Governance and Accreditation

Year 12 Academic Achievement 2022

- 31% of students (who shared their results with the school) were awarded an ATAR over 90.00
- 96% of Year 12 students were awarded a QCE (Queensland Certificate of Education) or QCIA

NAPLAN Academic Achievement 2022

Craigslea SHS's Mean Scale Score for all test areas (reading, writing, numeracy, spelling and grammar and punctuation) was above that of the nation, Queensland and Metropolitan Region in both Years 7 and 9. The student participation rate in all tests at Craigslea SHS was also significantly above the nation, Queensland and Metropolitan Region.
